An Act authorizing the creation of a debt of the State of New Jersey by the issuance of bonds of the State in the sum of twenty-one million dollars (\$21,000,000.00) for the relief of the people of the State from the hardships and suffering caused by unemployment and the effects thereof on the public health and welfare; providing the ways and means to pay the interest of said debt, and also to pay and discharge the principal thereof; and providing for the submission of this act to the people at a general election.
