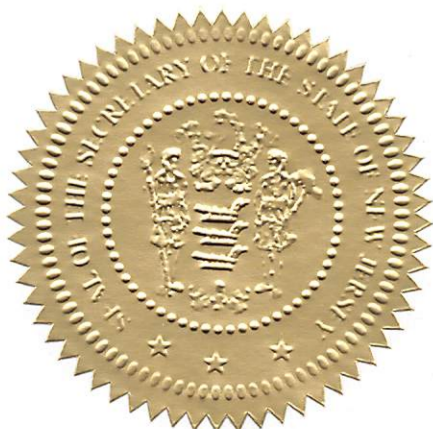

Dear Mr. Giles:

I am writing to you concerning the Rules Governing the Selection and Allocation of Delegates to the Republican National Convention adopted September 29, 2015, which were previously provided to you.

An issue has arisen as to Rule 8(B) relating to at-large delegates. In the Rules, there is revealed to be eleven (11) at-large delegate and alternate delegate positions statewide. In fact, the Republican National Committee has advised our client that New Jersey has twelve (12) at-large delegate and alternate delegate positions. See correspondence from RNC dated June 25, 2015 annexed hereto.

In light of the above, I am respectfully requesting that your office update the petitions to reflect twelve (12) (and not eleven (11)) at-large delegate and alternate delegate positions statewide. My office will advise the RNC, and the presidential campaigns who have contacted us concerning the Rules (Rubio, Kasich and Cruz).
